




Nude Food Day

An import opportunity for all parents

Dear Ermington Parents,

I am writing to you to let you know of a great opportunity to help your children and others at our Annual General Meeting which will be held Wednesday 7th November, 7:30pm in the School Library.

The P&C allows our children and community to enjoy:

- A canteen with healthy and reasonably-priced food
- A uniform shop providing quality clothes.
- The Biennial Fete a fantastic day where EPS and the wider community eat, play and raise funds for the school. (This raised \$40,000 for the school in 2017)
- Kiss and Ride, Disco, Movie and Trivia nights, End of year Party Days, Mother's Day
 & Father's Day BBQ's and sausage sizzles and lot's more.

Perhaps most importantly, the school has benefited from over \$60.000 in funds each year. In addition our P&C provides the ability to attract grants which amount to tens of thousands in funding for projects like the new COLA which was completed this year.

This all happens with the help of many parent helpers across all school years.

The group who coordinate all this effort are the members of the P&C Executive.

These roles are not overly time-consuming, but are essential for the ongoing running of the Ermington P&C Association. In short the main duties are:

- President (and 2 Vice Presidents) run the monthly general meetings, encourage and communicate with parents and liaise with the Principal on parentrelated matters. While some public speaking has been a feature of the role, there is no reason this can't be delegated to any member of the Executive.

- Secretary Act as a contact point for the Association and keep minutes of the meetings. This has been simplified by the use of the Trello app for organising agendas and minutes.

- Treasurer prepare / present a financial report for monthly Meetings and oversee
 the accounts. This is probably the most time-consuming of the roles, but we hope to
 share the tasks among more people in the year ahead. (If you are able to help with
 some book-keeping or paperwork please let us know.)

The roles can be largely performed out of hours with minimal impact on full-time work.

Please think about it and then come to the meeting so we can help each other to keep Ermington a great school.
